Greetings St James,

Our Cottage Meeting notes are still posted in the lounge because the Church Council looks to them each month to see if there is anything that can be addressed that month.

Here are some of the concerns we are attempting to address:

- Christmas Music: We intentionally added extra Christmas hymns to be sung during the Season of Christmas. This season runs from Christmas Eve to the Sunday before Epiphany.
- Not singing all the verses for long songs: There are many songs that have been shortened to just a few verses. Please note the bulletin Order of Worship to see if a song has been shortened for the day. Also, music is chosen to match the Scripture readings of the day. So, if there were verses that did not match the Scripture message for that day, we shortened the song.

- Sing songs that are more modern: We are restricted by licensing laws, so we use the music we have a license to use. There are licenses available that we could buy, but these cost more than you might think. We are looking into those possibilities and the kind of music offered. Additionally, the publisher for the ELW (our current hymnal) will be putting out a supplement by the Fall of this year. We are waiting to see a sample of the music.
- The church is too hot or the church is too cold: This is another of those times when we can't please everyone, so we are trying to please, at least, the majority. Protocols have been implemented to set the thermostat a few days in advance so we reach a desired temperature by Sunday morning. We simply ask that we do not have a lot of hands trying to turn the heat up or down, as this messes with the programming.
- The slides are hard to read: Our Technology Director, Tim, has been working with Anna to enhance the slides so they are easier to read. We welcome feedback.

 We get bored with the same Liturgy: We try to change the Liturgy with liturgical seasons, but I am pleased to announce that after Lent we will begin to learn a new Liturgy that we have not done before. It is a fun liturgy. I look forward to it.

The Church Council and the various committees have addressed quite a few other concerns. This current update addresses some of the "in-house" concerns, but we have, also, been engaged in quite a few evangelizing/outreach and other concerns. However, if I listed them all in this issue of the Visitor, the Visitor would double in size. I will speak about additional things we are busy working on in the April Visitor issue. Stay tuned and take the opportunity to read the Council reports.

Until then, please keep talking with your council members and myself. Healthy open dialogue is key to us building our future. Please remember, change and new programs take time.
